CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- (A) All municipal tree assets shall be protected using the Tree Protection Zone detail specified in the attached document "Tree Hoarding – Streets" and Schedule "A" of the Public Tree Preservation and Sustainability Policy.
- (B) All municipal tree assets identified to be removed shall be protected until the time of removal.
- (C) Pictures of the Tree Protection shall be sent to Urbanforest@hamilton.ca and approved by Forestry prior to work commencing.
- (D) Permitted tree removal activities shall be completed in its entirety, including site remediation and cleanup, within 48 hours of the removal commencement. Under no circumstances shall any part of a tree be left unattended in unsafe condition.
- (E) Tree removal work must be completed by a certified Arborist with the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA).
- (F) All stumps created through the above-mentioned removals shall have the stump(s) removed.
- (G) All debris shall be removed and disposed of off-site.

Permit is valid for a period of 3 years from Date Issued. Failure to comply with the permit is a contravention of the Hamilton Public Tree By-law No. 15-125. Amendments and extensions to this permit may only be issued by the undersigned or a person designated in his/her place within 30 days prior to expiration. This permit is non-transferable. The tree permit shall be attached to tree protection fence in a clearly visible location at all times during construction
